## 1. Business Continuity Policy

## 2. Business Impact Analysis (BIA)

- Have critical activities, dependencies, and resources been identified?
- Are maximum tolerable downtime (MTD) and recovery time objectives (RTO) defined?
- Is the BIA reviewed and updated regularly?
- Tip: A strong BIA helps prioritize resources and recovery efforts.

#### 3. Risk Assessment

- Have potential threats and vulnerabilities been identified?
- Are the likelihood and impact of risks assessed and documented?
- Are mitigation strategies in place for key risks?
- Tip: Risk assessments must be proactive and continually updated.

## 4. Business Continuity Strategies

- Have recovery strategies been identified for critical processes?
- Are alternate sites, suppliers, and communication channels available?
- Are continuity strategies tested and validated regularly?
- Tip: Strategies must balance cost with effectiveness to ensure feasibility.

### 5. Incident Response & Recovery

- Is there an incident response plan for different types of disruptions?
- Are communication procedures in place for stakeholders and staff?
- Have recovery plans been tested through drills or simulations?
- Tip: Regular testing builds confidence and ensures readiness.

## 6. Continuous Improvement

- Are lessons learned from incidents and tests documented and applied?
- Is the BCMS reviewed during management reviews?
- Are improvement opportunities tracked and implemented?
- Tip: Business continuity is a journey continuous improvement ensures resilience over time.
